# **Activities of Research Centre**

Centre for Research carried out many activities relating to research. It has completed two major research projects sanctioned by UGC. They are,

- 1. Causes and consequences of beggary: A Study in Madurai City' for which Dr. M.Kannan, Principal of the College is the Principal investigator and Dr.P.Ramasamy is the co-investigator.
